


FY11 Stats:

- Hotline Calls: 3,436 individuals were provided information, support and referrals
- Emergency Shelter: RESPOND's shelter housed 82 individuals: 44 families including 38 children
- Legal Services: 536 Individuals were assisted with court including restraining orders, accompaniments, and connection to legal representation
- Teen Dating: 3,600 high school students were educated in Teen Dating Violence Prevention
- **Support Groups**: 62 Individuals attended 110 groups
- Support: 793 Individuals received advocacy and counseling
- W High Risk Teams: 42 cases by 2 high risk teams were assessed for dangerousness, monitored, and received ongoing safety planning to prevent homicide.
- **Education & Training**: service 5,532 individuals in the community
