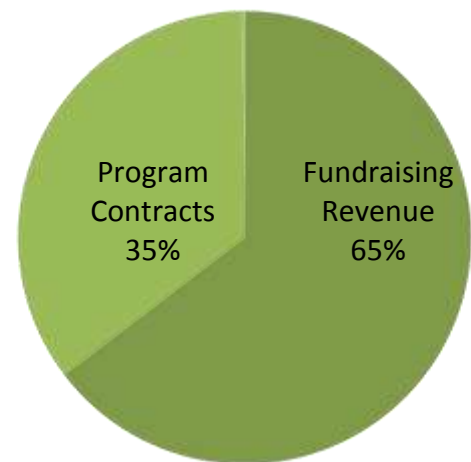

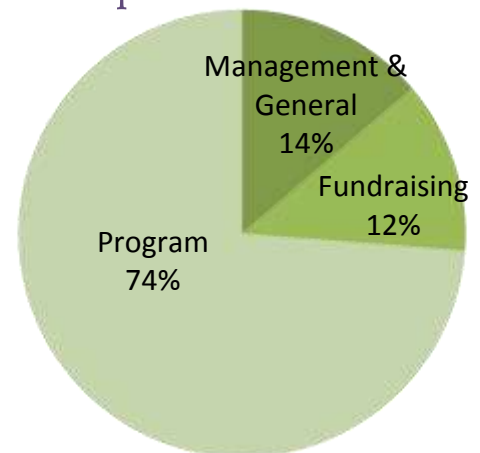
FY 12 Stats:

- Hotline Calls:** 2,433 individuals were provided information, support and referrals
- Emergency Shelter:** RESPOND's shelter housed 92 individuals – 44 adults and 48 children
- Legal Services:** 180 Individuals were assisted with court including restraining orders, accompaniments, and connection to legal representation
- Teen Dating:** Over 4,200 high school students were educated in Teen Dating Violence Prevention
- Support Groups:** Facilitated 233 group sessions
- Support:** 2,925 Individual advocacy and counseling sessions
- High Risk Teams:** 3,104 sessions were offered to assist with monitoring high risk cases for dangerousness, monitored and on-going safety planning and services to prevent homicide
- Education & Training:** 7,200 individuals received training
