## **PROGRAMS & SERVICES**

#CityofSomerville

**Legal Services**: 133 Individuals were assisted with court including restraining orders, accompaniments, and linking to legal representation. **Support Groups**: Facilitated 110 group sessions

**High Risk Teams**: RESPOND facilitates high risk teams from Somerville, Medford, Stoneham, Melrose, Malden, Reading, North Reading, Wakefield and Wilmington. RESPOND also participates in the Cambridge-Arlington-Belmont High Risk team which the organization co-founded in 2008. Over 200 people were accepted to a high risk team.

Education & Training: provided outreach and training to 6,806 individuals Hotline Calls: 3,571 individuals were provided information and support Emergency Shelter: RESPOND received 1,365 requests for shelter. Due to space limitations, only 76 were fulfilled (39 adults and 37 children). Teen Dating Violence: 3,283 middle school and high school students were educated in Teen Dating Violence Prevention

## CLIENT SNAPSHOT

- Most RESPOND clients were 20-50 years old. The average age was 37.
- 24% of RESPOND clients were married or divorced.
- 93% of RESPOND clients were women and 7% were men.
