Who We Are

RESPOND, New England's first domestic violence agency and the second oldest in the nation, was founded in 1974 to help victims of domestic violence and their families' access safety and support. RESPOND offers confidential services for ALL survivors of domestic violence including men, women, members of the LGBT community, and children. Our services include a crisis hotline staffed 24/7/365 by Domestic Violence Counselors, emergency shelter, support groups, housing assistance, children's services, community outreach, and education for individuals, businesses, and community and school groups.

What We Do:

- In FY18, RESPOND **served over 17,000 people** through community outreach, and **provided safe shelter for 73 survivors** of domestic violence.
- RESPOND answered over 3,000 calls on our 24/7 crisis hotline last year.
- W Last year RESPOND provided **191 support groups sessions** for survivors of domestic violence.

The Facts:

- 💜 1 in 15 children witness domestic violence in the U.S. every year.
- In MA, 1 in 3 transgender individuals will experience domestic violence in their lifetime.
