WHO WE ARE

RESPOND's History

A pioneer in the movement to end domestic violence, RESPOND is New England's first domestic violence agency and the second oldest in the nation. Its work began in the early 1970s, when four women from Somerville, Massachusetts started a grassroots effort to support victims of domestic violence by opening their own homes as safe havens for women fleeing abuse. In 1974, these "founding mothers" formed RESPOND, an organization that has provided life-saving shelter, support services, training and education programs to hundreds of thousands of members of the community for over 45 years.

The Facts

Domestic violence is a public health issue impacting families everyday.

- ▶ 1 in 3 women and 1 in 4 men will experience domestic violence in their lifetime.
- ▶ 1 in 3 adolescent girls in the U.S. are victims of physical, emotional or verbal abuse from a dating partner.
- In recent MA history, on average there have been at least 15 domestic violence related homicides each year.

Program & Services

RESPOND provides a range of support services and educational programs to over 10,000 adults, teens, and children each year. Through RESPOND'S programs, individuals and families in crisis develop the concrete tools necessary to regain control of their own lives.

Services are free, confidential, and available in multiple languages. Program and services include:
